

## PARKS BOARD REPORT May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013

## Parks Director Report

- Proposed Park Facility Rental Fees: Please see the attached proposed fee schedule
  for renting parks facilities. I would like to incorporate these changes so that all of
  our rentals are handled the same in regards to our different user groups. I would
  also like to be able to market the Pavilion Center rates as all-inclusive. I anticipate
  seeing an increase in our weekday rentals of the Pavilion Center by making them
  more affordable.
- Camp Update: Enrollment has picked up for summer camp! We still have spots open but we had over 20 campers take advantage of our Early Bird registration special (50% off non-refundable registration fee if completed by May 1st). We have scheduled training dates for our Camp Counselors and are in the process of interviewing our volunteer Junior Counselors.
- Music in the Park Update: Dates for this summer's Music in the Park series are June 21<sup>st</sup>, July 19<sup>th</sup> and August 16<sup>th</sup>. We have moved the event from Thursday nights to Friday nights in an effort to increase attendance. The Thunder Brothers are scheduled to play on June 21<sup>st</sup> from 7-9pm. We are in the process of finalizing sponsors for this program as well as the July and August bands. Flyers and other marketing materials for the program will be available soon.
- Safety Concern: With the nice weather, we have had an increase in the number of skateboarders in the park. While we are happy that they are enjoying the park, where they are choosing to skate is creating a safety concern. They are frequently using the hill by the Red Barn and the curvy part of Whipple Lane. The maintenance staff and I have noticed that the majority of the skateboarders are not paying very close attention to the vehicle traffic. I am concerned that because the areas they are skating in have blind spots/low visibility for drivers that an accident may occur. I would appreciate the Board's input on whether or not we should implement a policy that limits skateboarding in these particular areas.
