# Fire Chief's Report

# January 2018

January was a busy month for the fire department. To begin with, we saw an increase of 58 runs for January of this year as compared to January of last year. Obviously, not specifically an indication of the rest of the year, but if it is, we will have quite a busy year.

Last month we also saw the beginning of our Civilian Paramedic program. The two individuals that we hired at the end of last year, completed their training period and hit the streets a couple of weeks ago. In addition to these new personnel, we also extended offers to 5 additional personnel, and they all accepted the positions. We still have a couple of positions that need to be filled that we hope to have completed so that we can start the entire group of new personnel at the same time.

Last month, we were also very busy on the CPR front. Chief Allen, Karen and some of our shift personnel presented CPR training for the school for school bus drivers and teachers. In addition to the school, they also provided training to a group of supervisory personnel from Harlan Bakery. Last month, we also received some new CPR equipment that was purchased by IU West Hospital. Today, we did a photo op with some personnel from the hospital and an article should be out soon talking about the new equipment. Thanks to Karen for contacting the hospital for reaching out to the hospital, and thanks the IU West for providing all of the equipment that we needed to replace some out of date models. The American Heart Association recently advised educators that they would need to transition to newer equipment that gives students immediate feedback when working with mannequins. The hospital not only bought us new mannequins, but also new AED training devices.

We are currently finishing up the grant process that was started last month for new self-contained breathing apparatus, as well as new radios. We are contracting with a grant writer who is finishing the paperwork, that was due last Friday. Because of a problem with the grant website, we were given an extension until today. We are also currently working on a grant through the Indiana Department of Homeland Security for new fire hoods. There is a new style on the market that provides a greater level of protection to toxins with an improved barrier. That grant is due at the end of the month.

In closing, I would like to recognize Firefighters Nick Kane, Mitchel Jenkins and Firefighter Paramedic Keith Cox. Last week, a lady stopped on the apron at Station 142 with a flat tire. She

had already called AAA to have the tire changes for her, but these three gentlemen braved the cold weather and changed the tire for the lady so that she could get back on the road to a pending doctor's appointment. Thank you gentlemen for your fine work and your dedication to the residents that we serve, and for displaying the core values of our department. Great job!




