TRUSTEE REPORT

1. Tonight we will be asking your approval on the 2014 Township Observed Holidays and the 2014 Township Board Regularly Scheduled Meetings.
2. Tonight we will be asking approval for the 2014 Tax Anticipation Warrant (TAW) that will allow us to pay bills for the first part of 2014.
3. We have scheduled a special board meeting on December 4<sup>th</sup> at 7pm for the purpose of approving Additional Appropriations.
4. We are in the process of calculating and then invoicing both the Town of Danville and the Town of Brownsburg for the amount owed us for lost fire property tax revenues in the areas they annexed.
5. Tonight Chief Smith will be presenting a review on Squad 141
6. We will also be reviewing tonight the Township's Drug Testing Policy.
7. You will be receiving notice soon about a "Joint Meeting of Boards" of the various taxing entities and other key groups in the Avon Community during the first quarter of next year.
8. We should have by the time of tonight's meeting our 2014 renewal rates for our group medical plan. If we do I will be announcing it.
9. The County Trustee's representative ,Tim Griffith, for the County Communications Center Governing Board has asked that the Trustees replace him for 2014. The County Trustees met December 13<sup>th</sup>. If a quorum was present then I should be able to announce who that is at this board meeting.
10. At next month's meeting you will be asked to move funds between groups- ie Personnel Services, Supplies and Other Services of a particular Township Fund- ie Fire, Park, etc.
