

# Parks Department Board Report August 8, 2017 (reporting on July)

#### **Administrative Update**

- We had a very exciting summer here in the park with our Avon Kid's Camp. It was great to see the camp grow and hear our name around town. We are hoping to expand on our camp for next year and prepare to grow even more. I wanted to give a special thank you to the counselors for making this a memorable summer.
- Brauman Construction has started on the renovations to the Volleyball Court. We are very excited to see the final product. We feel that this will be a great addition to the upper park.
- The Cub Scouts donated 8 benches to the park. They donated these because of our cooperation with their summer camp this June.
- Last month we were contacted by the host for GenCon, a convention experience downtown. They are offering us a booth free of charge to promote our Gamer Night series. We will be attending all three days to promote our events.
- Fall registration has officially started and we are seeing an increase in registration. We have already hit the 60 mark for our Harry Potter Trivia night and our Haunted Bridge Investigation sold out in 3 days. Some great programs coming up this fall.
- We have begun the process in recruiting all of the taxing entities to create a community wide Recreation Guide for Avon. This magazine would include Washington Township Park, The Town of Avon, Library, Chamber, AJAA, and the School Corporation. We will be meeting this next month to discuss this new opportunity.
- We have been working hard this month to finish a more detailed budget for Pecar Park and getting all of the documentation ready for our meeting with the Town of Avon.
- Our recent flooding at the beginning of July did some damage to the creek bank at the south end of the pond behind the Pavilion Center. This location is where the Town of Avon plans to put their White Lick Creek Trail in 2018. I spoke with Ryan and had him come out to take pictures. He thinks that he might be able to talk with the Army Corp of Engineers and get some Federal Funding to fix our erosion problem.

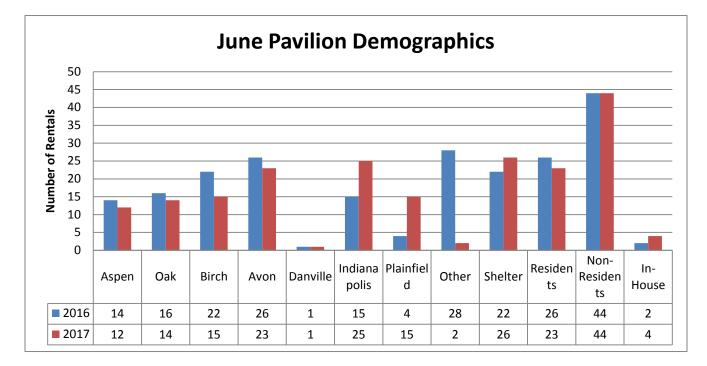
