Administrative Update

- Camp has come to an end and we are starting to miss all of the chaos. Camp went very smoothly
 this year and we have had a lot of parents asking us to continue the camp in the fall. We have
 spoken to our Lead counselor who is a substitute for Avon schools and she will be returning as
 our Camp Director in the fall. We are very happy to have her on board.

 Recreation guide whether they wanted to or not. It was a successful event I am working to see
 how we can bring it to Washington Township Park next year.
