

A MESSAGE FROM THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP/HENDRICKS COUNTY TRUSTEE:
"Moving to The Next Stage"

Governor Holcomb has announced that he is moving the state to Stage 4. The following is the changes made that will be Stage 4 for the Township:

- The Township Government Center will now be open to the public during normal business hours. You will still need to have your temperature taken. Anyone who has been sick or has a temperature exceeding 100.0 F will not be allowed to remain in the building. Also social distancing will be required and masks are recommended.
- Township Assistance will continue to be done remotely. Call 317-272-1835.
- Fire Station tours may resume by appointment through Public Educator. Temps will be taken and Social Distancing will be required.
- Public Education programs, CPR and community relation programs may resume.
- The Park Pavilion will still remain closed to the public EXCEPT by appointment. Temperatures will be taken and anyone who has been ill or has a temp exceeding 100.0 F will not be allowed in the building.
- The Nature Center at Pecar Park will now be open to the public at half capacity during posted hours. Temperatures will be taken and anyone exceeding 100.0 F or has been ill will not be allowed to remain.
- Rentals for the Pavilion will now be allowed up to 250 participants. Temperatures will be taken and anyone greater than 100.0 F will not be allowed to remain. Social distancing will be required and masks are recommended.
- Park programming may be up to 250 participants. Temps will be taken and social distancing will be required.
- Camp will require temps to still be taken and social distancing will be followed.
- The following amenities will now be open under this Stage:
 - + The Splash Pad + The Fitness Station
 - + The Playgrounds + Campground Restroom ShowersParticipants are requested to practice Social Distancing. Parents are encouraged to have children wash or sanitize their hands after playing.
- Although the Township will be cleaning buildings, restrooms, playgrounds, fitness center and splash pad daily, the Public is advised that using the facilities they could be exposed to COVID and **are doing so at their own risk.**
