Administrative Update

- The Pecar property holes have been fixed and filled. We are excited to have all capital projects started and finished.
- This year we have been given the green light to turn Washington Township Park into a winter wonderland. We will have lights displayed throughout the park featuring iconic Christmas characters such as the Grinch, Who's in Whoville, and Santa. The light show will be a free amenity to the community and we will be encouraging people to drive through each night. With that being said between 11/25 ½ the park will be open until 10pm.
- The maintenance staff has been busy getting ready for the winter season ahead. We are getting trucks cleaned, oil changes, and also maintenance to each plow.
- We are excited to announce that the office is fully staffed again. Alisha Gibboney has been hired
 on as our Part-Time Recreation Coordinator. Alisha was an amazing asset to the Department
 during the Ghosts and Goblins event. With her fresh ideas and drive I am excited to see the
 programming for 2016.
- This month I am excited to announce that we have reached an all-time high of \$2932.84 for catering revenue for this month. We are now at 119.3% towards our revenue goals.
- Do to the increase in demand for the Pavilion Center Don, Pat, Stephani and I sat down and came up with a price increase based on similar rentals in the area. The price during Peak rental season April – December \$2250 for residents and \$2750 for non-residents.
